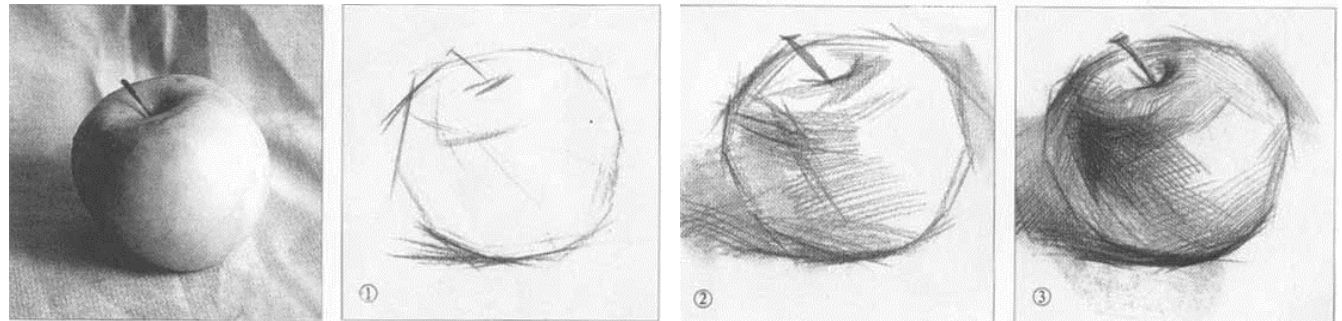

Task 1

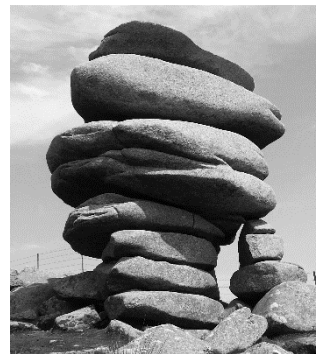
