Fieldsketch challenge

In Geography we can record what we see when we are out and about by drawing a fieldsketch.

This is a simple picture of what we can see but has detailed annotations to describe the scene. An annotation is more detailed than a label, for example a label might be 'sky'. An annotation would be 'bright blue sky with only a small number of clouds.' Fieldsketches should not take long to draw, it is the annotations that are important. Have a go at drawing a fieldsketch from a window in your house. What can you see? A good fieldsketch is drawn with a pencil, inside a box, has the horizon drawn, the main features that can be seen, has detailed annotations and a title to say what it is a fieldsketch of.
